2. PURPOSE OF THIS PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy aims to give you information on how TLR International Laboratories collects and processes your personal data through your use of this website, including any personal data you may provide through this website. It is important that you read this Privacy Policy together with any other Privacy Policy or fair processing notice we may provide on specific occasions when we are collecting or processing personal data about you so that you are fully aware of how and why we are using your data. This Privacy Policy supplements the other notices and is not intended to override them.

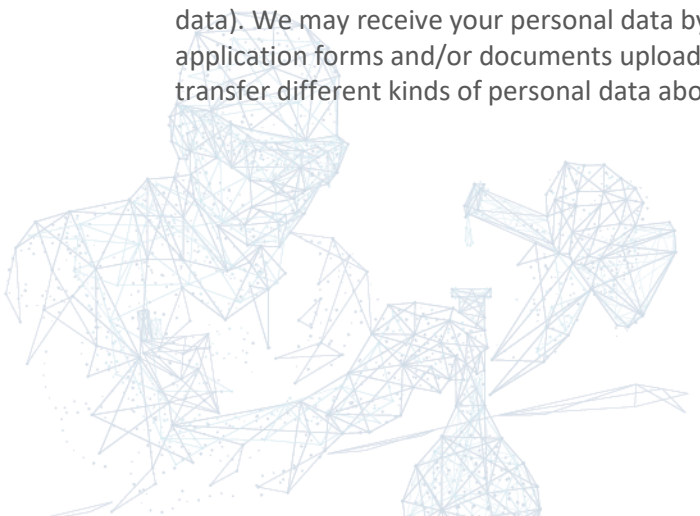
3. WHO IS TLR INTERNATIONAL LABORATORIES

TLR International Laboratories (“Company”, “we”, “us”, or “our”) is a flexible, market-driven laboratory that analyses a wide range of products in the field of foodstuffs, animal feeds, and (bio) fuels. 4. WHAT PERSONAL DATA DO WE COLLECT ABOUT YOU

Personal data, or personal information, means any information about an individual from which that person can be identified. It does not include data where the identity has been removed (anonymous data). We may receive your personal data by your usage of our website, completion of our website application forms and/or documents uploaded to our website by you. We may collect, use, store and transfer different kinds of personal data about you which we have grouped together follows:



- **Identity Data** can include first name, maiden name, last name, username or similar identifier, marital status, title, home address, postal code, date of birth and gender, qualifications and professional experience.
- **Contact Data** includes email address and telephone numbers.
- **Financial Data** includes bank account and payment details
- **Technical Data** includes internet protocol (IP) address, your login data, browser type and version, time zone setting and location, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform and other technology on the devices you use to access this website.
- **Profile Data** includes your username and password, your interests, preferences, feedback and survey responses.
- **Usage Data** includes information about how you use our website, products and services.

We also collect, use and share Aggregated Data such as statistical or demographic data for any purpose. Aggregated Data may be derived from your personal data but is not considered personal data in law as this data does not directly or indirectly reveal your identity. For example, we may aggregate your Usage Data to calculate the percentage of users accessing a specific website feature. However, if we combine or connect Aggregated Data with your personal data so that it can directly or indirectly identify you, we treat the combined data as personal data which will be used in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

5. HOW DOES TLR INTERNATIONAL LABORATORIES USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

We will only use your personal data when the law allows us to. Most commonly, we will use your personal data in the following circumstances:

- Where it is necessary for our legitimate interests (or those of a third party) and your interests and fundamental rights do not override those interests.
- Where we need to comply with a legal or regulatory obligation.

Generally we do not rely on consent as a legal basis for processing your personal data other than if we explicitly ask you for consent for a specific purpose.

6. PURPOSES FOR WHICH WE WILL USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA

We have set out below, in a table format, a description of all the ways we plan to use your personal data, and which of the legal bases we rely on to do so. We have also identified what our legitimate interests are where appropriate. Note that we may process your personal data for more than one lawful ground depending on the specific purpose for which we are using your data.
